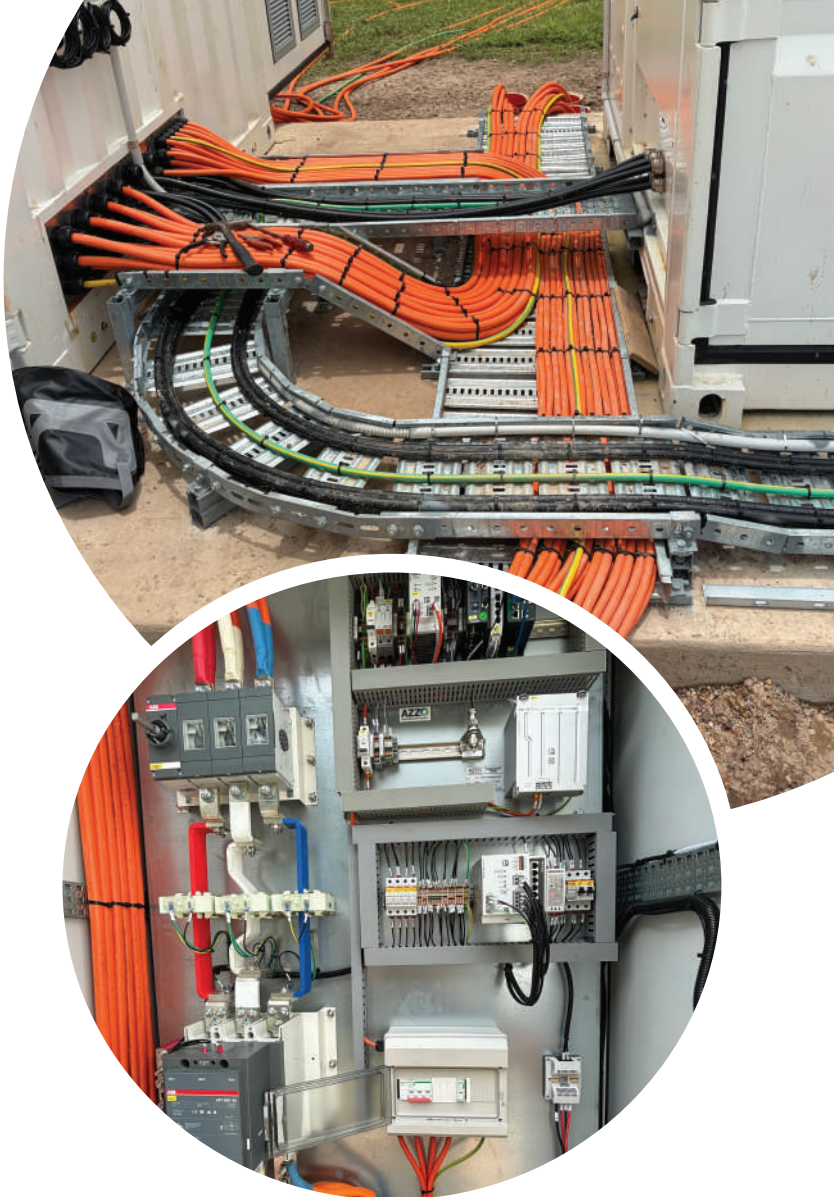

The project involved installation and integration of electrical infrastructure supporting renewable energy generation and battery storage systems across multiple operational sites.

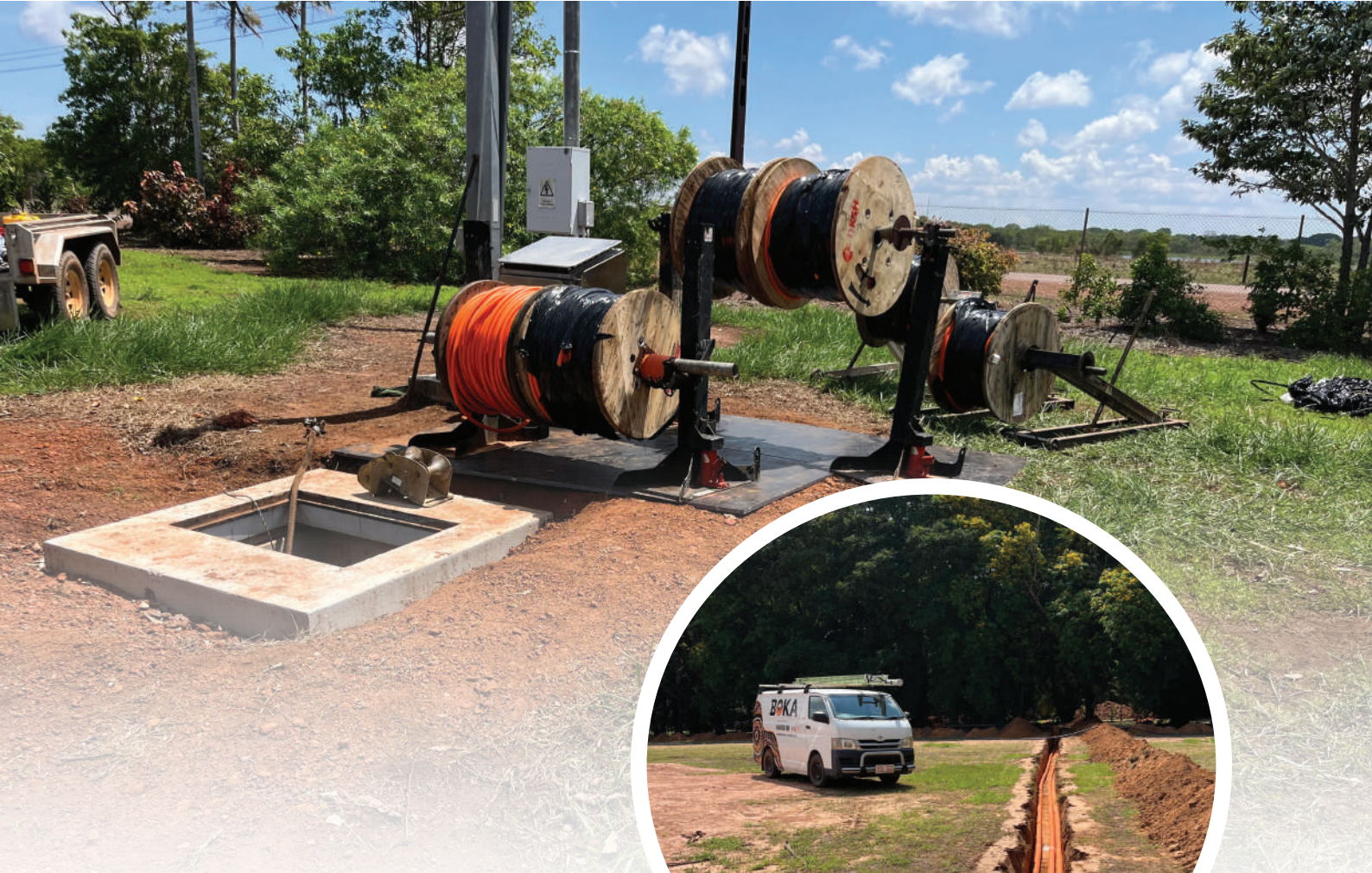


Scope of Works
